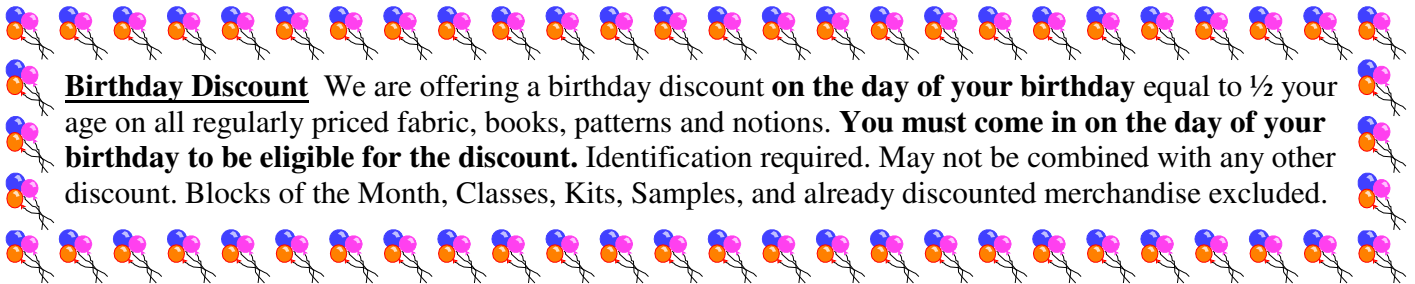
September 21 & 22: Quilt-A-Fair at Boulder County Fairgrounds in Longmont, CO Visit us in Booth 701

Advanced Design, Session II Six month Series

In this class we will cover a variety of different subjects including an in depth study of form and content, emulating a famous artist's style or arts era, working in our techniques but in a different medium instead of our own. We will also learn about several different surface embellishment techniques including the use of hand stitches such as "ricing", using metal and wire form, burning and meltable fabrics, how to raise the surface and other intriguing techniques. This class is for students who have completed the Language of Color and Design Series.

Language of Color and Design Nine Month Series

Students learn about batting, needle and thread types great for hand quilting along with information on products and how to's for marking and basting. Then we jump into how to "rock" as we learn to make small even quilting stitches. For beginners or anyone struggling with the hand quilting stitch.

Doodle & Dance: Introduction to Machine Quilting

Saturday, November 3, 2007 3 hours 10:00 A.M.-1:00 P.M. \$35.00

This class is for quilters with no previous quilting experience or those who are struggling with poor results. Students will learn how to properly baste their quilts and find out about choices in marking and no marking techniques. They will learn how to get the most out of their walking foot and get a good start on exploration with free motion techniques. Must have a sewing machine able to drop or cover the feed dogs and a walking and free motion foot.

Free Style Machine Quilting Design Saturday, November 3, 2007 3 hours 2:00 P.M.-5:00 P.M. \$35.00

For those with some free motions experience who are struggling with the design aspect of the process. Learn how to visualize and make the most of the positive and negative space on your quilt tops as you bring them to life. Bring several quilt tops for discussion. No machine required.
